The World Pops Meeting and Championships is an un-official World Championships for POPs and SOS in six disciplines.

COMPETITIONS

The event when the competition will start and the order in which each event will be held is totally dependent on the weather. The Meet Director and Chief of Judges will decide the schedule.

For instance, with clear blue skies in the first day, we will start with FS-4 Nationals, if the weather will not allow high jumps, accuracy will be done instead. Each day will be decided which events will be jumped according to weather conditions. We want to make the most on every kind of weather to jump any part of the competition jumps. This will be briefed daily to you. The information will always be available on our website and will be communicated at the beginning and end of each day.

A few days before the competition, Villarrica hosts the traditional parachuting water competition, a fun and unique competition open to anyone who wants to participate. You open your parachute, fly a few minutes observing a wonderful landscape to land in a beautiful warm water lake.



PRE-EVENT TRAINING JUMPS

The Drop Zone will be open for training/fun jumps from February 12th. Fun Jumps and Training Jumps:

Jumps paid and not used will be fully refunded.

PARTICIPATION

All competitors must be members of their POPS national organization. They must prove their membership showing a valid membership card. As an option, the respective national TOP POP (or his alternate) can guarantee for them including all Nationals POPs Members into a signed form.

For safety reasons, the organization reserves the right to verify the skydiving experience of the participants. On arrival each jumper must produce his skydiving license and proof of experience such as Skydiving logbook or CoP and packing data for all his equipment including AAD.

As Chilean Safety Rules states, foreign parachutists are required to maintain and operate their equipment under regulation of their own country. The use of AAD and any kind of helmet will be mandatory.

Reserve repack cycle in Chile is 180 days, however, the Regulations of the country of origin of the athlete will be respected. In such case, to clarify competitors (or their national delegate) must send us digital copy of their own Regulations.

SAFETY RULES

- All equipment will be controlled and ticketed by our Security Officer.
- Equipment that does not meet the safety standard rules will be grounded and cannot be used in any jump.
- A left-hand landing pattern is in use on DZ (Downwind 90 degrees left base 90 degrees left – final). Any operational change or exception for this rule will be explained during Kick off meeting.
- Dangerous maneuvers (hook turns, low passes overcrowded zone) which could cause damages to parachutists, visitors, or infrastructure are strictly forbidden, and in case of disqualification No Refund will be applied.
- Low pull as well as not following the rules of approaching to the landing zone are not allowed.
- In offences, the Drop Zone Safety Officer can exclude the transgressor from further jumps. No refund politics will be applied.

Drop Zone Skydive Pucon is in Villarrica Airfield, Cautin Province, Araucania Region, Chile. Villarrica is 760 kms. south from Santiago, capital city of Chile.

The closest international airport is Santiago Int'l Airport (SCL), at 680 kms. from Temuco and 760 kms. from Villarrica. Santiago Int'l. Airport Arturo Merino Benitez (SCL) receives flights from the most important cities of the world. If you want to fly via Argentina, the closest International Airport is Neuquén City Airport (NQN).

Closest national airport is Temuco Airport (ZCO) that has about 3 or 4 commercial flights per day only from Santiago International Airport (SCL). Transfer from Temuco Airport to Villarrica City will be available under request. Please contact us, we will be happy to help you.

Aircrafts

Cessna 180/182 and/or 206 will be used for Accuracy training jumps before February 19th. Cessna 208 Caravan and/or DHC-6 Twin Otter will be used for Classic Accuracy Landing, Sports Accuracy Landing, Hit'n Rock, National Formation Skydiving, Formation Skydiving Scrambles, SOS Formation Skydiving and for 8-Way Speedstar.













JUDGING EQUIPMENT

Electronic Scoring Systems.

A Complete Weckbecker Scoring System owned by Chilean Skydiving Federation (PARAFECH) will be used, for Accuracy Competition. **Dead center is 2 cm.**

Windsocks and Streamers

Large and small windsocks and streamers as Competition Rules states, will be used. Also, a 4 meters high wind speed meter with over speed alarm, will be used.

Equipment and Staff

Skydive Pucon and Latin-American Skydiving Confederation COLPAR Siglo XXI will provide the necessary equipment and staff under POP/SOS competition rules to ensure the competition proceeds safely and in timely manner.

All acting Judges are qualified under international (FAI and/or COLPAR) or National (PARAFECH) requirements. Complete panel will be shown in Bulletin N° 2.

PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM

There is a Public Address System installed in the Aero Club which will be extended, and additional coverage will be provided as required.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Citizens of the following countries do not require visa to enter Chile for tourism purposes.

Visit for less than 90 days: <u>USA (with Reciprocity Fee)</u>, Albania, Andorra, Argentina, <u>Australia (No Reciprocity Fee, only e-visa)</u>, Austria, Bahamas, Barbados, Belgium, Belize, Bolivia, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, <u>Canada (with Reciprocity Fee)</u>, Colombia, South Korea, Costa Rica, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Ecuador, El Salvador, UAE, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Hong Kong (HKSAR passport), Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Moldavia, Monaco, Montenegro, Nicaragua, Norway, New Zealand, Netherlands, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Romania, Russian Federation, St. Kitts and Nevis, San Marino, Santa Lucia, St.





Vincent and the Grenadines, Serbia, Singapore, South Africa, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, Taiwan, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, Ukraine and Uruguay.

Visa for less than 90 days: Venezuela and Cuba.

Entry request fee

To enter Chile, the nationals of the following countries must pay a "reciprocity fee" in accordance with the following chart.

The Chilean Government set this entry fee on equal amounts to the fees Chilean citizens must pay when requesting a visa to travel to those countries.

Nationality	Fee	Number of entries
Canadian	USD 132	Multiple entries (10 years or up to one month before passport expiration's date)
USA Citizens	USD 160	Multiple entries (10 years)

Note: Fees subject to modifications based upon reciprocity. Or its equivalent in Chilean pesos.

The payment of this fee is NOT a visa since Chile does not require visa to citizens of the above-mentioned countries when traveling for tourism purposes.

Those foreign citizens who have already paid the Reciprocity Fee in the past and it is still valid, do NOT have to pay the fee again.

HEALTH AND IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Vaccination requirements are changing frequently so updated information should be consulted prior to travel. Chile has a strict control system to ensure that no non-native diseases are brought in, but after the World Health Organization declared the end to the Public Health Emergency of International Concern, Chile's Health Ministry has put an end to the measures of the Protected Borders Plan.
